Numerous people are descending on a small, colourful Greek island of Kalorkairi as Sophie's dreams are about to come true, when she finally marries her boyfriend Sky. Sophie fantasizes of the perfect wedding — one which includes her father walking her down the aisle and giving her away.

The problem? She doesn't know who her father is!

Sophie's mother Donna, the former lead singer of the 1970s pop group 'Donna and the Dynamos' and owner of the hotel Villa Donna, which is currently buzzing with wedding guests, refuses to talk about the past, so Sophie decides to take matters into her own hands.

Sneaking a peek in her Mother's old diaries, Sophie discovers three possible fathers:
An architect Sam, a sailor Bill, and a banker Harry, none of which Donna has seen in over 20 years.

#### <u>AUDITION INFORMATION & REQUIREMENTS</u>

- All auditionees are required to make an audition booking by calling 1300 881 545.
- Auditionees must be 18 years of age or over at the time of your audition.
- Please prepare TWO songs in the style of the show which demonstrate your vocal range and storytelling ability.
- Audition songs may not be heard in full, so please choose an appropriate starting place or prepare a cut that you
  feel best represents your skills.
- No songs from the show are permitted however pop songs are acceptable.
- If auditioning for a particular character, please take note of the vocal type and character required.
- Only sheet music may be used and all sheet music must be in the correct key, in a folder with the cuts clearly
  marked. No transposition, backing tracks or acapella singing will be accepted.
- Auditionees may be asked to sing some scales and/or some oral exercises depending on the requirements of the role/s they are auditioning for.
- All auditionees auditioning for a role will be required to read dialogue in their audition.
- We are looking for a very diverse cast of all ages, genders, sexual orientations, cultural backgrounds.

#### OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Rehearsals will be held on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 7.00pm to 10.30pm and Sunday afternoons from 12.00pm to 5.00pm.
- There may be a requirement to start some Sunday rehearsals from 10.00am.
- Cast may be required to attend costume measurements before our first official rehearsal with a date TBC.
- The first official rehearsal will be held on Sunday 2 February, 2020 from 1.00pm to 5.00pm
- There will be 2 rehearsal weekends planned to be held on the following;
  - o Saturday 29 February 2020 Sunday 1 Mar 2020
  - o Saturday 4 Apr 2020 Sunday 5 Apr 2020
- Cast are required to assist with bump-in on either Friday 24 April, 2020 and/or Saturday 25 April, 2020
- Cast are required to attend all rehearsals during production week Sunday 26 April to Thursday 30 April, 2020.
- Performance dates are from Friday 1 May, 2020 to Saturday 16 May, 2020.
- Cast are required to assist with bump-out after the final performance on Saturday16 May, 2020.

## **CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS**

CHARACTER	Vocal Range	Character Description
Sophie Sheridan Age: 18-25	Soprano, Mezzo-Soprano (F#3 - E5)	Donna's headstrong 21-year-old daughter, Sophie is determined to find romance and have what her mother never had: a traditional family and a father to walk her down the aisle. Young, bright and energetic, she has lived all her life on the island and is ready to leave.  Songs: I Have a Dream, Honey Honey, The Name of the Game, Lay All Your Love on Me, Under Attack, among others.
<b>Donna Sheridan</b> Age:35-50	Mezzo-Soprano, Alto (E3 - A5)	The owner of the Taverna on the Greek island of Kalokairi, Donna is Sophie's mother. Attractive and free-spirited, she is the former lead singer of "Donna and the Dynamos. Honest, straight and hard-working, she a strong feminist but is the most naturalistic and vulnerable of the characters. Delivers some of the biggest solos in the show.  Songs: The Winner Takes it All, Slipping Through My Fingers, Dancing Queen, Super Trooper, Money Money Money, among others.
Sam Carmichael Age: 40-50	Baritone (D3 - Ab4)	One of Sophie's Potential fathers and a wealthy architect. Sam has regretted leaving Donna all his life and now finds himself divorced and back in her presence. He is straight-laced, confident and composed. At times he is perhaps a little over-bearing, but he is determined not to mess up the second chance he has been given a very true and honest character within the chaos. Songs: .S.O.S., Thank You for the Music, Knowing Me Knowing You, among others.
Bill Austin Age: 40-50	Baritone (Bb2 - F#4)	Another of Sophie's potential fathers, a well-known travel writer, Bill has visited the far reaches of the earth, but never found what he's really looking for. A real character, Bill has generally avoided the complexities of a relationship and now wonders if it's too late. Lots of comedy and a golden heart within.  Songs: Thank You for the Music, The Name of the Game, Take a Chance on Me, among others.

Harry Bright Age: 40-50	Tenor, Baritone (C#3 - F#4)	Another of Sophie's potential fathers and a respected London banker. Once a head-banging, partying musician who went down the straight road - at least with his career. He is quirky, in the closet and something of a romantic nostalgist. A nice guy, determined to make up for some past regrets and full of singing.  Songs: Thank You for the Music, Our Last Summer, among others.
<b>Sky</b> Age: 25-35	Tenor, Baritone (Eb3 - D5)	Sophie's fiancé; a former stockbroker who moved to the island in a young version of a mid-life crisis. He is older than Sophie, but smitten by her exotic charm. Perhaps he is too eager to please and has not quite found all the answers he had hoped for on the island. Songs: Lay All Your Love on Me, among others.
Tanya Chesham-Leigh Age: 30-45	Mezzo-Soprano, Alto (E3 - E5)	One of Donna's oldest and best friends, Tanya has married several millionaires and discovered a lot more about plastic surgery than love - to the extent that she was ever looking. Rich, wild, fun-loving and a big character, she flirts mercilessly with young men, happy to play, but not to stick around.  Songs: Chiquitita, Dancing Queen, Super Trooper, Does Your Mother Know, among others
Rosie Mulligan Age: 30-45	Alto (E3 - D5)	Donna's friend (around 40, American, often plus-size) a former member of the Dynamos; unmarried, free-spirited and a renowned author of cookbooks. A character who has developed a confident, funny and self-deprecating exterior which masks her inner vulnerability. Mostly comic, yet one of the most poignant moments in the show in the heart of Act 2. Dances like nobody's watching. Songs: Chiquitita, Dancing Queen, Super Trooper, Take a Chance on Me, among others.
Lisa / Ali Age: 20-35	Mezzo-Soprano (G3 - D5)	Sophie's friends who have traveled to the island for the wedding. A supporting double-act of bubbly, energetic bridesmaidy excitement, not necessarily gender-defined.  Songs: Honey Honey, among others.
Pepper / Ensemble Age: 20-35	Tenor, Baritone (A4 - F5)	A flirty waiter at the Taverna featured through his brief relationship with Tanya. Hot, energetic and fun-loving, makes a great double-act with Eddie. Opportunity for a good mover. Songs: Take a Chance on Me, among others.
Eddie / Ensemble Age: 20-35	Tenor, Baritone	A waiter, boatman and handyman at the Taverna. Other half of double-act with Pepper. Fairly nonspecific. Opportunity for a good young character actor to create something interesting.
Ensemble Age: Various	Vocal: Varied	Seeking strong male and female singers and dancers who will be doing couples choreography, as well as featured in ensemble numbers. They will support the cast throughout the entire show. Consists of the Islanders, who work at Donna's, Wedding-Guests.
